**FREE** Childcare Pilot Program  
(for Battle Assembly and Annual Training activities)  
that the Army Reserve initiated in October 2023?

The Army Reserve Childcare Pilot Program is available in  
New York, Florida, Texas, and California.

The new childcare benefit is available to USAR Soldiers of ALL ranks, whether TPU, ADOS, or AGR. We highly encourage Soldiers to take advantage of this pilot program.

Children must be between the ages of 6 weeks to 12 years old.

Soldiers may establish care at their home of record or duty station. The Soldier must live or attend BA in the one of the pilot states. For example: A Soldier can live in Florida and attend BA in Georgia and still be eligible for childcare services in Florida or Georgia! Likewise, a Soldier can attend BA in Florida, live in Georgia and receive childcare benefits in either location!

Availability for this extraordinary resource is a on a first-come, first-served basis.
